## General Rules Concerning LROCT Club Activities Trips and Functions

- 1. All official Club activities, trips and functions shall have the approval of the Committee of Management or at a General Meeting prior to the commencement of each event.
- 2. All members, their guests and visitors shall obey directions from the Organiser or Trip Leader.
- 3. Members shall advise the Organiser or Trip Leader of their intention to participate in a club activity, function or trip as early as possible.
- 4. Vehicles participating in Club activities should meet certain minimum standards with regard to equipment:
  - a. vehicles shall be fitted with suitable rated recovery points at the front and rear (tie down points and tow balls are not acceptable).
  - b. vehicles shall carry recovery equipment suitable rated to recover that vehicle.
  - c. vehicles should have a fitted 5 watt UHF radio for communication between vehicles.
  - d. If the Trip Leader deems a vehicle is unprepared for an activity he may refuse that vehicle's participation.
- 5. When using power tools or recovery equipment members shall wear prescribed or recommended personal protective equipment. It is strongly recommended that any members using a chainsaw on a club trip should have a chainsaw license.
- 6. Trail bikes and firearms are prohibited on all club events unless permission has been obtained from the Committee of Management.
- 7. Alcohol is not to be consumed during a club trip until all organised driving activities for a particular day have ceased unless approved by the Trip Leader.
- 8. Animals are not permitted on trips except at the discretion of the Trip Leader.
- 9. When answering the call of nature please take a shovel and bury the waste.
- 10. Rubbish shall be deposited in rubbish bins or taken home.
